**Special Called Meeting of the Town Council
Friday, June 21, 2019 – 9:00 a.m.**

A special called meeting of the Iva Town Council was held on Friday, June 11, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the Iva Town Hall, located at 204 E. Jackson Street in Iva. Notice of the meeting was given in compliance with the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act.

1. Call to Order

Mayor Gentry called the meeting to order.

2. Invocation

3. Pledge of Allegiance

4. APPOINTMENTS – Boards and Commissions

5. UNFINISHED BUSINESS – (Ordinances – Second and Final Reading)

- a. Ordinance 2019-007 – Providing for the issuance and sale of a Town of Iva, South Carolina, Special Obligation Bond, Series 2019, in the principal amount of not exceeding \$200,000.

Mayor Gentry and Mr. Taylor discussed the bond issuance with council members. Ms. Forrester made a motion to approve second and final reading, seconded by Mr. Powell. All were in favor. The vote was 4-0.

6. NEW BUSINESS – (Ordinances – First Reading)

- a. Ordinance 2019-008 – Amending the Town of Iva “Purchasing Ordinance”, Amending Section 2.2; Amending Section 2.4.

Mayor Gentry and Mr. Taylor commented regarding the amendments to the Purchasing Ordinance. After discussion, Mr. Powell made a motion to approve first reading. Mr. Hart seconded the motion. All were in favor. The vote was 4-0.

7. NEW BUSINESS – (Resolutions – First and Final Reading)

- a. Resolution 2019-007 – Providing for and enacting a Reasonable Accommodations Policy as required by Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

Ms. Forrester made a motion to approve the Resolution for first and final reading, seconded by Mr. Powell. All were in favor. The vote was 4-0.
