Call to Order - The meeting was called to order by Mayor Gentry at 4:00 p.m.

Invocation – The Invocation was offered by Mr. Hart.

Pledge of Allegiance – Everyone stood and pledged allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

4. <u>CONSENT AGENDA</u>

 Approval of Minutes – January 10, 2022
Mr. Hart made a motion to approve the minutes of January 10, 2022, seconded by Ms. Forester. The vote was 5-0.

Mayor Gentry invited Ms. Kathy Hipp, Superintendent for Anderson School District Three, to address council regarding plans and updates to the ball field and library project. Ms. Hipp commented that their architect's are working on plans for the school bus relocation to the ball field. As soon as she receives the plans, she will share with Mayor and Council. Ms. Hipp commented that a possible traffic light may be installed at Hwy 81 and Hamilton Street due to that being the main entry road for the buses. Ms. Hipp also commented that she is working with Anderson County and the Anderson County Library Board in regards to purchasing the current library building and relocating the library to the old Iva Fire Department.

There was concern regarding the full space at the old fire department and the Antique Body Shop's use of the building. The library will benefit from the full use of the facility – meaning the town will need to find another building for the Antique Body Shop.
